#### Eat

- Gordon Ramsey visited and loved it. Featured in Oprah Magazine. Enough said. Come to <u>The Pheasant</u> <u>Restaurant</u> for jazz Mondays, bison burgers, pheasant lettuce-wraps, and sample the artisanal olive oil and balsamic vinegars.

- G8 <u>South Dakota Art Museum</u> features the world's largest collection of Harvey Dunn paintings, other unique exhibits, and a gift shop filled with locally-made products and artwork. Free admission.
- G8 The farmer in your life, and everyone else, will appreciate the <u>South Dakota Agricultural Heritage</u> <u>Museum</u> and its exhibits and gift shop. Free admission.
- G8 The recently remodeled historic Carnegie library building is home to the <u>Brookings Arts Council</u>.
  Stop in to see the latest exhibit or participate in various workshops. Discover <u>The Artful Dozen</u> sculptures throughout the community. Free admission.
- Find the six life-size mural paintings that are part of the <u>Urban Canvas</u> downtown Brookings (part of The Artful Dozen).
- Watch a world-class music or theatre performance in the expanded <u>Performing Arts Center</u> on the SDSU campus.
- Enjoy a concert or rodeo at Swiftel Center!

### **Outdoors**

 G8 - McCrory Gardens Education & Visitors Center is the premier botanical garden of South Dakota, stroll the grounds and take in the frequent special events and attractions.

- <u>Dakota Nature Park</u> used to be a landfill, but now it is one of the most beautiful areas in Brookings. Kayak, paddle board or fish (catch and release) in one of the ponds. Walk or bike the beautiful trails, or simply take in the tranquil beauty of nature. In the winter, snowshoe or cross-country ski!
- Beat the summer heat! <u>Hillcrest Aquatic Center</u> has four different pools, tree-topping water slides, fountains and piping that drizzles and sprays pool-goers.
- The same crews who design BMX trails for the Olympics created <u>SouthBrook Pump Park</u>. Bike on three different tracks, suited for all ages and abilities.
- Catch some air or do a backside at the **Skateboard Park**.
- Fido's favorite place! The <u>Bark Park</u> dog park has three fenced in areas for small dogs, large dogs, and an agility course.
- Try your hand at disc golf! <u>Larson Park Disc Golf</u> has an 18-hole course...pro tip: be aware of the discenting slough behind hole 12.

# Sports

- G8 <u>Brookings County Outdoor Adventure Center</u> allows for indoor shooting sports enthusiasts to practice their sports year-round.
- Cheer for the Jackrabbits at an SDSU football game in the new **Dana J. Dykhouse Stadium**.

#### Landmarks
